

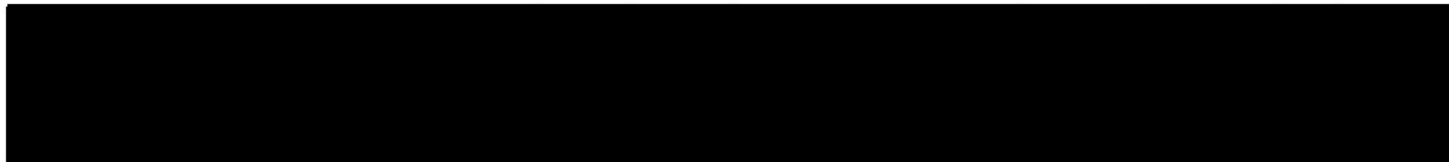

Ms. McGriff was employed by the State of Florida's Department of Corrections in the Department's Probation and Parole Office in Crawfordville, FL during the timeframes these messages were sent.

Your affiant respectfully submits, probable cause has been established in that, Kelly McGriff committed the criminal violation(s) of; Introduction of Contraband into a Correctional Facility, with the contraband articles being written messages sent via cellular phone, in violation of §944.47 Florida State Statute in Crawfordville County, Florida.

Before me, Circuit Court Judge Ronald W. Flury, personally appeared Lead Senior Inspector Ryan Muse, who being sworn, deposes and says:

COUNT 1: Introduction of Contraband

That Kelly Janaye McGriff, a Correctional Probation Senior Officer, on or between the dates of: August 21, 2020 to September 25, 2020, did then and there unlawfully introduce contraband in the form of written or recorded transmissions via text messages, phone calls, written and recorded electronic transmissions (emails or messages), into the secure perimeter of a State of Florida Correctional Institution, and to an incarcerated inmate, contrary to Florida Statute 944.47(1)(a).

Your affiant has documented his probable cause in a complaint affidavit attached to this document as EXHIBIT A; wherein, the above violations are further explained. Your affiant swears that EXHIBIT A is true.
