The Undersigned Certifies and swears that he has just and reasonable grounds to believe and does believe that the above-named Defendant committed the following Violations of the law: on January 20, 2022, at 12:48, AM PM (Specially include facts constituting cause for arrest)

Your Affiant is Inspector James Padgett (*Inspector Padgett*) with the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) for the Florida Department of Corrections (FDC), and the defendant is Mr. William Hutchinson (*Mr. Hutchinson*) who is employed by the FDC at Wakulla Correctional Institution (WCI). Your Affiant has conducted an investigation into Introduction of Contraband and Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance resulting in the following:

On January 20, 2022, while employed and entering the secure perimeter of WCI, Mr. Hutchinson was observed on camera retrieving an unknown item of contraband from inside his pants after being processed through the metal detector area and prior to being pat searched. This intern led to Mr. Hutchinson being interviewed by Inspectors Padgett and Maria Fender (*Inspector Fender*) concerning the contraband in which he concealed.

During his interview, Mr. Hutchinson [Redacted] Mr. Hutchinson consented to having his green in color 2009 Jeep searched by Inspectors Padgett and Fender.

While conducting a search of the driver's side front seat area, Inspector Padgett discovered a clear zip lock style bag consistent with drug sales that contained a white residue. The contents were field tested by Inspector Padgett utilizing a Sirchie Nark Cocaine ID Swipe and yielded a positive result for the presence of Cocaine.

Based on the field test results and the bag being found in the vehicle owned and admittedly driven by Mr. Hutchinson, probable cause has been established that Mr. Hutchinson did knowingly enter institutional grounds with the controlled substance and introduced contraband onto the grounds of.
