Your Affiant is Inspector Chris McGauley with the Office of Inspector General for the Florida Department of Corrections (FDC), and the defendant is Chadd Petrik, a former inmate with the Florida Department of Corrections. Your Affiant has investigated the Introduction of Contraband (attempted) into the Hamilton Correctional Institution (HCI) by Mr. Petrik.

The Undersigned Certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following Violation of the law:

On the 4 day of October 2019 at 7:00 🖾 AM. 🔲 PM (Specially include facts constituting cause for arrest)

I was contacted by Lead Senior Inspector Chip Potter (LSI Potter) in reference to allegations of a visitor in possession of contraband at Hamilton Correctional Institution (HCI). Upon my arrival I was briefed of the situation by FDC Canine Sergeant Jackie Morgan (Sergeant Morgan). Sergeant Morgan received credible information from other staff and conducted a search of the wooded area, on FDC, HCI property, outside of the secure perimeter HCI Annex (HCI-A). Sergeant Morgan notified Hamilton County Sheriff's Department of the issue and additional deputies arrived for assistance. Sergeant Morgan activated Suwannee Correctional Institutional Canine and they also responded to HCI. Sergeant Toby Anastasio (Sergeant Anastasio) worked a track with K-9 Fancy to the rear of HCI-A in the wood line adjacent to the fire line. Sergeant Anastasio located a Petrik, lying in a wood line adjacent to the located contraband (approximately 10 feet). Petrik led Sergeant Anastasio to the contraband which he had been in possession of. Deputy Pearsall Fouraker (Deputy Fouraker) responded and detained Petrik on an unrelated outstanding warrant. Deputy Fouraker Mirandized Petrik, who indicated post Miranda that he had been dropped off by two females in a van. Prior to Petrik making this statement, local law enforcement officers conducted a traffic stop on a van, within the area of HCI, with two female occupants. The occupants advised they were lost and were escorted to a local hotel, Budget

Inn. After the statement from Petrik was made to Deputy Fouraker additional Deputies responded to the Budget Inn and reestablished contact with the van occupants.

Senior Inspector Lee McGauley (SI McGauley), and Inspectors Chris McGauley (your affiant) and Brittany Jordan (Inspector Jordan) met with and conducted post Miranda interviews of the two females who occupied the van, Deborah Gregory (Gregory) and Vicky Saunders (Saunders). Both testified similarly to transporting Petrik from Port Richie, FL, to an unknown wooded location in Jasper, FL. Upon Petrik exiting the vehicle, Gregory and Saunders drove around and were stopped by local law enforcement, so they left the area with local law enforcement and registered into the Budget Inn at Highway 6 and Interstate 75.

SI McGauley and your affiant interviewed Petrik post Miranda and noted the following: He woke up in a wooded area and does not know how he got there and refused to provide any additional details.

The contraband consisted of four (4) flip style cell phones, six (6) touch screen smart phones, one (1) Posh mobile phone, one (1) Zancoe mini cell phone, six (6) mini Airhead candies in a cd case with loose pennies, and 136 grams of unfiltered cigarettes. These items (cell phones, candy, pennies and cigarettes) were photographed, packaged and submitted for evidence in the TSL (Temporary Storage Locker) at HCl in the Inspectors Office.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established Chadd Petrik did commit the violation of twelve (12) counts, Introduction of Contraband (cell phones) in violation of § 944.47 (1)(a)6, and six (6) counts, Introduction of Contraband (unauthorized food items) in violation of § 944.47 (1)(a)2 in Hamilton County, Florida, Hamilton Correctional Institution on October 4, 2019.

All supporting documents referred to in this affidavit will be available for judicial review and will be further explained in your affiant's report of investigation.
