SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS:

On February 6, 2012, shortly after being involved in a physical altercation with Inmate Carmelo Figueroa, Inmate Julio Pintado **Geographica Control** and the second second

SUMMARY OF DISPOSITION/JUSTIFICATION FOR DOWNGRADE/EXONERATION:

As a result of this investigation, it is determined that Inmate Carmelo Figueroa has violated **Florida Statute 782.04** (*Homicide*) by virtue of being involved in a mutual combatant physical altercation with Inmate Julio Pintado, which resulted in Pintado's death.

Upon approval by the Office of the Inspector General, a copy of this investigative report will be submitted to the Office of the State Attorney for the 6th Judicial Circuit for review and consideration of criminal prosecution.

FINDINGS:

On Monday, February 6, 2012, at 3:15pm, Inmate Julio Pintado was pronounced dead by a second second

I arrived at Zephyrhills CI at approximately 4:00pm and met with Correctional Officer Michael Barrington, who had witnessed the physical altercation between Inmates Pintado and Figueroa.

In his sworn recorded interview, and subsequent Incident Report, Officer Barrington indicated the following:

At approximately 1:15pm, while assigned as the Laundry Officer, he was in the office of the Laundry Building when he heard some loud arguing coming from the area of the dryers. As he exited the office,

he observed Inmates Pintado and Figueroa several feet away standing in close proximity to each other and yelling loudly at each other. He could not understand what they were saving because both were velling at each other in Spanish. He walked over to the area and asked the inmates what was going on. Figueroa responded that Pintado "keeps running his mouth" and "he's pissing me off". He then told both inmates to stop arguing and to walk away from each other, at which time they ceased their arguing and "backed off" from each other. He (Barrington) then turned around and began walking back towards the office. A few seconds later, he heard what sounded like a loud "slap". As he turned around, he saw Figueroa strike Pintado on the side of the face with his hand. At that point, both inmates began slapping each other repeatedly with their hands. He immediately ordered the inmates to cease fighting but they continued to hit each other and chase each other around the room. At one point, Figueroa struck Pintado in the upper torso area with his fist, causing Pintado to lose his balance and fall backwards to the ground. At that point, Figueroa backed away and the fight ended. Both inmates were then placed into hand restraints by responding staff and escorted towards the Confinement Building. Both inmates were as they were being escorted away. At no point did he ever observe any weapons being used during the altercation. He also did not either inmate. Barrington stated that he did not recall any problems between Figueroa and Pintado in the past, adding that, to his knowledge, both inmates had been close friends. However, he had heard that the inmates had a "falling out" regarding an unknown issue over the previous weekend. (Exhibits A1, A9& B1)

According to Officer Barrington, Inmates Creach, Hollingsworth, Prine and Cook were also present in the Laundry Building when the incident took place. No other staff members or inmates were present at the time.

In his written statement and subsequent sworn recorded interview, Inmate Creach stated the following:

On the date and time in question, he was present in the laundry area where the altercation between Pintado and Figueroa occurred and did observe the entire incident. He advised that both inmates began yelling at each other in Spanish near the dryers. He could not understand what they were saying but believed the argument was a continuation of previous arguments they had had with each other earlier that day and over the last few days. At one point during the argument, Pintado lunged towards Figueroa. Both inmates then "went at it", indicating that they both began fighting with each other. For the first several seconds, the fight consisted of them slapping each other with their hands. Pintado then began running away and Figueroa was chasing him around the tables. Pintado then grabbed a wooden clipboard that was lying on a table and turned and struck Figueroa over the head with it, breaking the clipboard in half. Figueroa then struck Pintado with his fist, (he was unsure where Figueroa struck Pintado), knocking him down onto the floor. Figueroa then stood over Pintado and said something to him in Spanish before backing away. Officer Barrington then interceded and the fight ended. Both inmates were then separated until backup security arrived. When security arrived, both inmates were then placed into hand restraints and escorted out of the building. Creach estimated that the entire altercation lasted only about thirty seconds. He advised that after the fight, both Pintado and Figueroa appeared shaken and were



In their witness statements and subsequent sworn recorded interviews, Inmates Hollingsworth, Prine and Cook all advised that they did witness either part of or all of the incident. All gave the same general account of the incident as was given by Inmate Creach and Officer Barrington. None offered any additional or conflicting information. All of the inmates confirmed that Pintado and Figueroa had been close friends but had had a recent "falling out" over the last few days regarding unknown issues. None of the inmates knew what had specifically led to the argument that preceded the physical altercation nor did any understand the argument itself due it to being in Spanish. (Exhibits A3-A5, A11-A13 & B1)

The area in which the incident occurred is a large open room with several long tables located throughout. The broken clipboard that Pintado allegedly used to strike Figueroa was recovered from the scene and placed into evidence. An evidence was observed or recovered. Multiple digital photographs were taken of the area. (Exhibit B2)



After being read and waiving his Miranda warnings, Inmate Figueroa was interviewed and provided the following sworn recorded statement:

On the preceding Friday (*February 3rd*), he and Pintado got into a minor argument regarding their work assignment in Laundry. This argument led to several additional arguments over the next two days. On the date and time in question, while working in the Laundry Room, he approached Pintado and confronted him about not washing his (*Figueroa's*) clothes. Pintado then threatened to "stab" him. (*He stated that neither of them possessed any weapons*). He then pushed Pintado backwards. Pintado then kicked him back and they both then began striking each other with their fists. He then started chasing Pintado around the tables. At one point, Pintado grabbed a clipboard and hit him in the face with it. He then punched Pintado in the face, causing him to fall to the ground. He then stood over Pintado and told

him that he did not want to fight him anymore. He then backed away from Pintado and nothing further took place. Figueroa stated that he never intended to cause any harm to Pintado, claiming that he and Pintado had been very close friends and had never been involved in any physical altercation with each other prior to the one on this date. (Exhibits A14 & B1)

It should be noted that Figueroa was informed of Pintado's death just prior to the commencement of this interview. Figueroa was visibly distraught throughout the interview, crying audibly several times during its course.

On February 7, 2012, an autopsy was performed on Inmate Pintado by Dr. Dollett White at the District Six Medical Examiner's Office (*attended by Inspector Lisa Roberts*). No immediate cause of death could be determined at the time of the autopsy. Digital photographs were taken. (Exhibit B4)

The autopsy report was received on May 10, 2012. According to the report, the cause of death was determined

The manner of death was listed as homicide.
