SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION	NS:					
On November 24, 2010, Officer Raymond Davis reported while conducting rounds in disciplinary confinement, at approximately 2:03 p.m., he discovered Inmate Joey Mixon, in cell #A-109, (housed alone) hanging by a piece of cloth tied to the heater vent in his cell. Officer Toriano Peterson responded and the two officers entered the cell and relieved pressure on the inmate's neck until Officer Tara Bibbs arrived with the "cut-down" tool. The inmate was cut loose, pronounced Inmate Mixon deceased at 2:22 p.m.

SUMMARY OF DISPOSITION/JUSTIFICATION FOR DOWNGRADE/EXONERATION:

As a result of this investigation, it is determined that Inmate Joey Mixon, DC# 099788 did at the Bay Correctional Facility while housed in confinement cell #A-109, by use of a strip of cloth to fashion a noose, secured the other end to the heater vent in his cell the based on the fixed-wing video footage, autopsy results, physical evidence and witness statements.

Additionally, there appears to be no administrative violations surrounding this incident. It is recommended the investigation be downgraded.

FINDINGS:					
In his digitally re	ecorded interview, dated	November 24, 2010, Office	er Raymond Da	vis indicated the following:	
He was conducting his rounds in confinement and observed through the window of cell #A-109, Inmate Mixon hanging from a noose, tied to the vent in his cell. He called for assistance and when Officer Peterson arrived, they entered the cell and took the pressure off the inmate's neck. Officer Bibbs entered and assisted in cutting the inmate down. There were no prior problems and no indication of trouble in Inmate Mixon's cell. (Exhibit B1)					





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In her digitally recorded interview, dated November 24, 2010, Officer Tara Bibbs indicated the following:

She heard a call over the radio that an inmate was hanging in confinement. She entered the confinement unit and heard Officers Peterson and Davis calling for the cut down tool. She recovered the tool and returned to assist. She attempted to cut the noose but due to the positioning of the officers and her short stature, she could not reach the sheet to cut it. Officer Davis took the tool and cut the strap. The inmate

In his digitally recorded interview, dated November 24, 2010, Officer Toriano Peterson indicated the following:

He returned back inside confinement from exercising an inmate in the exercise pen outside the unit. Officer Davis began his rounds as he was still at the inmate's cell. He heard a call from Officer Davis stating he had an inmate hanging. He arrived at cell #A-109, entered the cell with Officer Davis and assisted in holding up the inmate to relieve pressure. When the cutting tool arrived, she (Officer Bibbs) had a problem in reaching the sheet. He grabbed the tool, cut the sheet and

Inmates Thomas Larson DC# B05355, cell #107 and Charles Chaney DC# Q01163, cell #104 were digitally interviewed by Inspector Skipper and had no information of importance to the case. (Exhibits B9 & B10)





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In an affidavit, recovered by Senior Inspector Debra Carter, dated November 24, 2010, Inmate Bradley Beck, DC# P15298 indicated the following:

He had been in confinement for nine days. He knew the inmate cell #109, named Mixon, as "Jewie". "Jewie" told him he had received some bad news from his family. He didn't talk about it much and did not go into details. On this date (11/24) he did not hear much from the inmate. (Exhibit A3)

A Bay Correctional Facility Confinement A-Segregation housing log indicated a "Watch Tour" was conducted At 2:05 p.m., it was noted that an inmate is "hanging" and assistance is requested.

Inmate Mixon is pronounced deceased at 2:20 p.m.

A Daily Record of Segregation dated November 24, 2010, completed on Inmate Joseph Mixon, DC# 099788, indicated that he received recreation at 7:54 am and his noon meal was served at 10:26 am both incidents indicated (Exhibit A5)

The fixed-wing camera footage, Bay Correctional Facility, dated November 24, 2010, for A-dormitory, confinement, Channel 13:00 hours through 15:00 hours, was recovered and indicated the following:

Video footage confirmed the A-dormitory count at 13:01:00 (video time). At an officer made a check of Inmate Mixon's cell. The inmate is last seen moving in front of his cell door window at 13:40:19. At 14:03:12, an inmate is being escorted back to his cell on the second floor by Officers Peterson and Davis. At 14:04:47, Officer Davis began his rounds on the second floor as Officer Peterson remained at the second floor cell. At 14:05:49, Officer Davis discovered Inmate Mixon hanging. At 14:06:56 Officer Davis and Peterson entered the cell. At 14:07:00, Officer Bibbs entered the confinement unit and proceeded out of the dormitory. She returned at 14:07:42 and entered the cell.

On November 27, 2010, an autopsy was conducted by Doctor Michael D. Hunter of the District Fourteen Medical Examiner's Office in Panama City, Florida. Inspector Rodney Coffey attended the autopsy. The preliminary findings indicated death was caused No indications of foul play were noted.





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In a Case Summary dated January 17, 2011, by Forensic Investigator Whit Majors, District Fourteen Medical Examiner's Office, Investigator Majors indicated the following:

On November 24, 2010, at 3:20 p.m., he was contacted by Senior Inspector Debbie Carter, Department of Corrections, Inspector General's Office, in reference to a hanging at Bay Correctional Facility. He was informed that at 2:05 p.m., the victim, Joseph Mixon, was found hanging from a white fabric ligature from a ventilation duct in his cell.
