


In his Incident Report and in his sworn affidavit, Sergeant Brian Spencer indicated that on 04/28/11, he was assigned as E Dormitory supervisor. At approximately he was conducting a security check in Quad 4 of E Dormitory. Spencer passed cell E4109, which was solely occupied by Inmate Steven Rivet. He looked into the cell from the outside and did not see Inmate Steven Rivet on his bunk. He took his flashlight and looked into the cell from the cell door window. He observed Inmate Rivet standing directly behind the cell door. Spencer verbally called for Rivet in an attempt to get his attention. Rivet did not respond. At approximately 12:48 A. M., he, Correctional Officer Joshua Sneider and Sergeant Ryan Thomas entered the cell. When they entered the cell, they observed Inmate Steven Rivet hanging by a small piece of white cloth tied around his neck from the top hinge on the inside of his cell door. There were several books found below Rivet's feet. The ligature tool was obtained, the cloth was cut and Inmate Rivet was placed on the floor.
