

On December 1, 2008, at approximately 5:20am, Inspector Kevin Snow and I watched the fixed-wing video from November 30, 2008, from 8:00pm until Inmate Morales was removed from his cell at approximately 1:01am on December 1, 2008, During the above time frame, there were no signs of foul play or misconduct. After reviewing the video, we went to Inmate Morales' cell and observed it. The cell was very dirty, had smell of urine, but no signs of any foul play. Inmate Jonathon Nuckols K63056, in which is directly across the hall, stated he knew Inmate Morales for about 4 years and Inmate Morales was placed across the hall so he could help watch him. He observed Inmate Morales falling in the cell numerous times. The last couple of days, his behavior had gotten worse and Inmate Morales


