FINDINGS:
On August 16, 2012, at 2:30am, I was contacted by On-Call Supervisor, Jeffrey Johnson to report to Tomoka Correctional Institution for a minimal investigation regarding Inmate Jeffery Williams #343456, housed in Protective Management in E-Dormitory.
In his Incident Report, and subsequent sworn digitally recorded statement, Sergeant Richard Sherman stated:
On August 16, 2012, at approximately and provided and provided a Formal Count of Edormitory. Upon completing the entire dormitory count and returning back to the Officer's Station, he heard screaming and banging coming from Wing E1-Wing 2. As he was responding to the Wing, he heard an inmate yelling, "He's hanging." He advised the Officer's Station to turn the lights on in the Wing. He looked inside E1211 and observed Inmate Williams hanging by a sheet tied around his neck from the top bunk with what appeared to be a part of a bed sheet. He then immediately radioed for assistance. He placed Ratliff in hand restraints and removed him from the cell. He then entered the cell and cut the sheet (using his keys) from the bunk which was wrapped around Williams' neck. He was able to get Williams onto the floor. Sherman said both, Williams and Ratliff were lying on their bunks during the Count. Sherman further indicated that there was nothing unusual about Williams' behavior on that prior evening.  (Exhibit A-1 & B-1)
In his sworn digitally recorded statement, Inmate Donald Ratliff stated:
He remembered that before he went to bed, Inmate Williams was sitting on the toilet after Master Roster Count around (1:00am). He was on his bunk (top bunk) with his ear buds in his ear with the music playing. At around 1:00am, he woke up and sat up in his bunk and noticed Williams was by the toilet kneeling down as if he was praying. Williams's hands were between his legs and his head tilted down. The lights were off. He then climbed down off the bunk and put his bed slides on. He glanced to the right and noticed Williams' (100am). His face was not a normal look. He then knew something was wrong. He touched Williams and tried to lift him up but could not and Williams (100am). That's when he panicked and began yelling and banging on the door for help. Sergeant Sherman responded immediately and handcuffed him and removed him from the cell. He stood in the Wing by the cell. Sergeant Sherman then went into the cell and cut Williams down and placed him on the floor.

Seconds later, the door opened and Inmate Ratliff was remove from the cell and stood in the hallway of the Wing with handcuffs on. Sherman immediately entered the cell at this time, Officer Cynova responded to the cell. At 12:38:16, two other officers responded and escorted Ratliff out of the Wing. At 12:38:18, Sherman and Cynova were kneeling down and appear to have by the view of their arms and head movements. Williams' body was inside the cell near the doorway with a portion of his body in view. At 12:38am, Captain Pendleton responded to the area. At 12:42:39am, Entered the Wing. Then at	e is en ed and
1:18am, Duty Warden Hodgson entered the Wing. At 1:18:45, with Williams At 1:21am, the cell was secured.  (Exhibit B-2)	
Inmate Williams had no phone activity on the Securus Phone System.	
Inmate Williams' were obtained and will be made a part of this investigative file.  (Exhibit A-	-3)

On August 16, 2012, an autopsy was performed on Inmate Williams by Timothy Gallagher, M.D., of Districts 7 & 24 Medical Examiner's Office. Doctor Gallagher indicated that Williams died and gave a preliminary finding of suicide as the manner of death.

This exhibit represents the sheet (ligature) which was placed in evidence at Tomoka C.I. Inspector General's Office evidence locker. (Exhibit B-3)

On August 21, 2012, Supplied that Indian Submitted an Incident Report indicating that Inmate Jacob Murray told her that Inmate Williams' and as reported. Murray heard Williams and his roommate, Inmate Ratliff arguing and fighting and believed Ratliff murdered Williams. (Exhibit A-4)

In his sworn digitally recorded statement, Inmate Jacob Murray stated:

On August 16, 2012, approximately 30 minutes before Count, he heard Inmate Williams say, "Please don't kill me." Also, he heard arguing and fighting coming from the cell. Approximately 15-20 minutes after Count, he heard Inmate Ratliff yelling for help because his roommate was hanging. Murray indicated that his roommate, Inmate Alvin Crews can support this. Murray's cell was next to Williams' in Protective Confinement.

It was only Murray's opinion that Ratliff killed Williams.

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In his sworn digitally recorded statement, Inmate Alvin Crews stated:

He denied that any of the actions described by Murray took place. He indicated that he was awake and did not hear any argument or sound of fighting coming from the cell. He never heard Williams yell, "Don't kill me." Crews said that 3 days after Williams 'death, Murray stated that he was going to lie and say that Ratliff killed Williams, so he could be transferred. He knew that someone would be coming to speak with him about Murray's lie.

On October 24, 2012, I received the Autopsy Report and the manner of death is classified as suicide (Exhibit A-5)

No criminal or administrative concerns were brought up or observed during this investigation.
