

| In an incident report dated 09/22/09, Officer Timothy Fowler indicated the following:   |
| At approximately during a formal count on the third floor of Q-wing, he and Sergeant Smith observed Inmate Lunz Control room and were notified. Lieutenant Cauwenberghs arrived and instructed Sergeant Smith to retrieve the ligature cutter. He (Fowler), Smith and Cauwenberghs entered the cell and he applied restraints to Lunz.  Lunz was then removed from the cell. (Exhibit A2)   |
