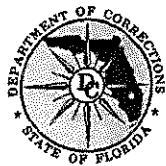

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS:

In an incident report dated July 13, 2009, Officer Jason Manuel stated at approximately 7:00 pm CST, he was stationed in E-dormitory officer's station (*only officer in dormitory at the time of the incident*) when Inmate Victor Sanchez notified him Inmate Jeffrey Zaveta DC# 692658, [REDACTED]. He looked and observed Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] between a bunk and the dayroom wall. He called for assistance and Sergeants Trotter, McDonald and Officer Hudson arrived followed by Officer Arrant. Sergeant McDonald stated in his incident report when he arrived he observed Inmate Howard Cheatham DC# 692658, sitting on Inmate Zaveta's bunk [REDACTED]. Inmate Zaveta told Sergeant McDonald he (*Inmate Zaveta*) had came from the bathroom area [REDACTED].

Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] by Holmes C.I. [REDACTED] at 1920 hours and [REDACTED] in Bonifay, Florida [REDACTED]. He was noted with [REDACTED] Panama City, Florida. The case was assigned as a RM as the evidence and witness statements indicated [REDACTED] no indication of foul play. Inmate Zaveta died [REDACTED] on July 19, 2009, [REDACTED]. On October 22, 2009, the case was discussed with Supervisor Stuart Harrison and up-graded to an investigative issue.



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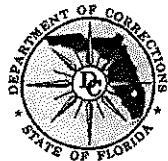
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SUMMARY OF DISPOSITION/JUSTIFICATION FOR DOWNGRADE/EXONERATION:

[REDACTED]

Inmate Zaveta was pronounced dead a 2:40 pm, July 19, 2009. On July 20, 2009, Inspector Rodney Coffey attended the autopsy and the preliminary findings by the Medical Examiner indicated [REDACTED]. The final autopsy report confirmed the preliminary findings. No [REDACTED] evidence or witness statements, were noted that would indicate foul play. A request for a downgrade of this case to an A-1 is forwarded as the death of Inmate Zaveta appeared to be [REDACTED] and was not caused by foul play. This was based on the evidence, interviews and conclusion of the autopsy results.

FINDINGS:

On July 13, 2009, at approximately 8:41 pm, Inspector Cecil Smith was notified by On-Call Senior Inspector Kelley Martin of a [REDACTED] at Holmes Correctional Institution (C.I.) Senior Inspector Debbie Carter and Institutional Inspector Rodney Coffey were also notified and assisted in the investigation. Inmate Jeffery Zaveta was [REDACTED] in Bonifay, Florida. He was then [REDACTED] in Panama City, Florida.

The incident was treated as a possible crime scene due to the unknown nature of the fall. A search of all inmates in the dormitory for [REDACTED] weapons was conducted. A search for missing combination locks or inmates without a lock, were checked and those found without a lock were found to have valid reasons as to why they did not own or have a lock. [REDACTED] discovered on any other inmate, clothing or articles. A search of the laundry room, trash and the dormitory was conducted with only one unrelated weapon being discovered under a sink, in the bathroom area. A green, state issued tooth brush, sharpened to a point, was found concealed in a sock under one of the sinks. Inmates identified as being in the dormitory, entering the dormitory or housed close to Inmate Zaveta, at the time of the incident, were questioned.

In his incident report dated July 13, 2009, Officer Jason Manuel indicated the following:

He was in the officer's station in E-dormitory when Inmate Sanchez approached the pass-through box, indicated an inmate had fallen [REDACTED]. He look to the area and noticed an inmate [REDACTED] between bunk #E2-146S (Inmate Zaveta's bunk) and the dayroom wall. He called for assistance. He then noticed Inmate Cheatham [REDACTED] Inmate Zaveta onto his bunk [REDACTED]. Sergeants Trotter, McDonald and Officer Hudson arrived. Inmate Zaveta was [REDACTED] and exited out of the dormitory. Sergeant Trotter and Officer Elmore began taking photographs of the area where the incident took place. There were no further incidents and at 9:10 pm, Inspector Smith, Colonel Swartz and Major Dyke entered the dormitory. (Exhibit A-1)



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In his incident report dated July 27, 2009 and his digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Debbie Carter, Sergeant Ronald McDonald indicated the following:

He responded to a call for assistance in E-dormitory, wing #2, due to an inmate [REDACTED]. Upon arrival he found Inmate Zaveta sitting on his bunk, leaning over with his head in his hands. He asked what had happened and Inmate Zaveta responded he was coming back from the shower, [REDACTED] and fell. When he (*Sergeant McDonald*) [REDACTED] he responded "no." He and Officer Arrant placed Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED]. The delay in writing his incident report was due to his being on annual leave the following day and leaving town. (Exhibits A-2 & B-1)

In his incident report dated July 13, 2009, Sergeant William Trotter indicated the following:

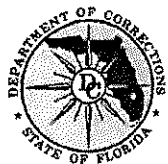
He responded to a call for assistance from Officer Manuel surrounding an inmate falling in E-dormitory, wing #2. He and Sergeant McDonald responded to the dormitory. Upon arrival he observed Inmate Zaveta sitting on his bunk with Inmate Cheatham [REDACTED]. He called for Officer Arrant to bring [REDACTED] Officer Elmore to retrieve a digital camera. He (*Sergeant Trotter*) then secured Inmate Zaveta's property in the laundry room and turned it over to Inspector Smith. He then took photographs of the scene. (Exhibit A-3)

In his incident report and an affidavit dated July 14, 2009, recovered by Senior Inspector Debbie Carter, Correctional Officer Daniel Stephen Arrant indicated the following:

He was one of the responding officers to a call for assistance in E-dormitory. At approximately 7:15 pm, he and Officer Hudson responded to E-dormitory [REDACTED] to wing #2 due to an inmate falling in the dormitory. When he arrived, Inmate Howard Cheatham [REDACTED] Sergeant McDonald with Inmate Zaveta, [REDACTED]. He placed the inmate [REDACTED]. (Exhibits A-4 & A-5)

Photographs of the scene of the incident were taken by Sergeant Trotter. It showed [REDACTED] the base of the wall, at the point of the base board. (*Note: The baseboard is a two inch, by two inch piece of wood.*) There [REDACTED] the floor away from the wall or on the wall above the first concrete block. There was no indication on the frame that Inmate Zaveta hit the bulletin board or the metal bed frame of his bed. [REDACTED] at the area of the bed where Inmate Zaveta was sitting. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Additional photographs were taken by this Inspector of the bulletin board, bed and area of the incident. (Exhibits A-6~A-10)



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In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 13, 2009, Inmate Howard Cheatham DC# 201969 (a.k.a. Game) indicated the following:

He was at his bunk and decided to go to the shower. He was moving towards the dayroom when he saw Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] trying to get to his bunk. He assisted Inmate Zaveta to his bunk and kept him sitting as he wanted to lie down. [REDACTED] and asked Inmate Sanchez to notify the officer in the station about Inmate Zaveta. He then asked Inmate Sanchez to wet some toilet paper with cold water. The officers arrived in the dormitory and he assisted in [REDACTED] he was taken out of the dormitory. At that time there were about 25 inmates in the dormitory and inmates were coming back into the dormitory from the recreation field. He knew Inmate Zaveta and knew he did not go to the recreation field. Inmate Zaveta did not [REDACTED] borrower money, or at least that he was aware of. He had last talked to Inmate Zaveta around 2:00 pm. He knew Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] as he would have other inmates get it from the officers and give them to him. He knew Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] He did not see Inmate Zaveta fall. (Exhibit B-2)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 13, 2009, Inmate Victor Sanchez DC# H18667 indicated the following:

He knew Inmate Zaveta for about 90 days and knew the inmate did not go to the recreation field or to chow very often. He knew of no problems with other inmates or the inmate gambling [REDACTED] He was not aware of any gang involvement. He had come in from the recreation yard and saw Inmate Cheatham helping Inmate Zaveta off the floor. Inmate Cheatham asked him to get an officer and he did. He did not see the inmate fall and did not know what happened to him. (Exhibit B-3)

In a sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 13, 2009, Inmate Eugene Dickerson, DC# 808789 indicated the following:

He did not see anything and only had been at Holmes C.I. for four days. He did not know the inmate and did not know what happened. He did not see the inmate fall. (Exhibit B-4)

In a sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 13, 2009, Inmate James St. John, DC# E30191 indicated the following:

He knew Inmate Zaveta and knew he was [REDACTED] He did not know of the inmate to gamble, [REDACTED] or involved with other inmates (boy friend). He did not see what happened to the inmate and heard nothing from any other inmate about what happened. (Exhibit B-5)



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In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 13, 2009, Inmate Tony Harrison, DC# 630413 indicated the following:

He was in the day room when the incident occurred. It was around the time the news on the TV was going off. He did not see what happened to the inmate. He knew of no problems with the inmate and others in the dormitory. **(Exhibit B-6)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, Inmate Lucas Talley, DC# 123158 indicated the following:

He did not see anything. He was talking a shower during the incident and when he came out he saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor. **(Exhibit B-7)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, Inmate Calvin Certain, DC# 503302 indicated the following:

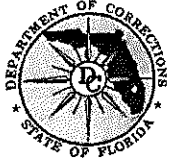
He did not see anything and knew nothing about Inmate Zaveta. **(Exhibit B-8)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, Inmate Adam Krell, DC# N15691 indicated the following:

He was on the yard, went into the dormitory and washed his hands in the bathroom. When he went back towards his bunk he saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor with his head against the wall. [REDACTED] Inmate Cheatam walked up and was helping the inmate get onto his bunk. He walked away and went on to his bunk. He did not see the incident or what caused the inmate to fall. He knew of no problems with Inmate Zaveta and other inmates in the dormitory. **(Exhibit B-9)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate Johnathan Williams, DC# 518044 indicated the following:

He slept behind Inmate Zaveta. Inmate Zaveta was a good guy, no enemies and tried to help a lot of inmates. He (*Inmate Zaveta*) told him he had been [REDACTED]. He (*Inmate Williams*) was in the dayroom and heard inmates coming into the dormitory from recreation. He heard some "unknown" inmate yell he (*Inmate Zaveta*) [REDACTED]. He went to the bedding area and saw Inmate Zaveta lying on the floor, right side of the face to the wall and legs pointing towards the bunk. There was only one officer in the dormitory and he was in the officer's station. He did not see what caused Inmate Zaveta to fall. **(Exhibit B-10)**



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In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate Floyd Lewiston, DC# T32432 indicated the following:

He returned to the dormitory from the recreation yard and as he entered the bedding area he saw Inmate Zaveta lying on the floor with his head against the wall. He did not see what happened. He was not aware of Inmate Zaveta having problems with other inmates and knew Inmate Zaveta helped other inmates out. (Exhibit B-11)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate Marty Glover, DC# 571208 indicated the following:

He moved into the dormitory "yesterday" but knew Inmate Zaveta "slipped and fell." He didn't talk to him much but it appeared he got along with everyone. He (*Inmate Glover*) took a shower and when he exited he saw an officer standing over Inmate Zaveta, who was lying on the floor. An inmate was helping him and he heard someone state [REDACTED] (Exhibit B-12)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate Cecil Gardner, DC# 101046 indicated the following:

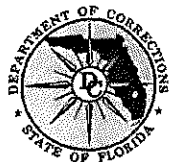
He took a shower around 5:40 pm and had just talked to Inmate Zaveta, who offered him to see his (*Inmate Zavala's*) magazine. He (*Inmate Gardner*) went to the dayroom and twenty to thirty minutes later an inmate (*can't remember*) told him Inmate Zaveta hit his head on the wall. He went to see what happened and [REDACTED] The officers already had taken Inmate Zaveta out. He did not see Inmate Zaveta having problems with other inmates. He knew Inmate Zaveta did not like going to the recreation field [REDACTED] (Exhibit B-13)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate Donald Hawkins, DC# P27106 indicated the following:

As he entered the dormitory and came around the corner of the hallway, into the bedding area, and saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor [REDACTED] Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] He did not see what happened but saw inmates helping him up and onto the bed, as an inmate got the officer's attention. He was not aware of problems with Inmate Zaveta and other inmates. (Exhibit B-14)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Senior Inspector Kelley Martin, Inmate William Hardisty, DC# 071257 indicated the following:

He went to the bathroom (*toilet*) and did a crossword puzzle Inmate Zaveta had given him. He exited the bathroom he saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor [REDACTED] An officer was there and [REDACTED] Inmate Zaveta was a "nice guy" with no problems with anyone. He heard from other inmates (*unknown*) that the inmate [REDACTED] (Exhibit B-15)



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In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, Inmate Luna-Martinez Rafael, DC# H21664 indicated the following:

He was not in the dormitory when the incident occurred and did not know anything about Inmate Zaveta. **(Exhibit B-16)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate David Sims, DC# J28132 indicated the following:

He was returning from recreation when he entered the dormitory and saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor. [REDACTED] He did not see the fall. Inmate Zaveta got up off the floor, on his own and sat on the bed. Inmate Cheatham [REDACTED] He did nothing as he did not know what to do. He later heard from another inmate (*unknown*) Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED] He knew of no problems with Inmate Zaveta and other inmates. He always got along well in the dormitory. He was a "straight-up dude." **(Exhibit B-17)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate Donavon Henderson, DC# V26721 indicated the following:

He had been in the dormitory for about three and a half weeks. He knew of no problems Inmate Zaveta had with any inmate but he did have a lot of people coming to his bunk. He (*Inmate Henderson*) was returning from recreation when he saw "Jeff" (*Inmate Zaveta*) on the floor, [REDACTED] A couple of inmates helped "Jeff" onto his bunk. He heard from other inmates (*unknown*) "Jeff" had fallen but he did not see him fall. **(Exhibit B-18)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate Derrick Reese, DC# P25132 indicated the following:

He came in from recreation and saw Inmate Zaveta on the floor. Nobody was helping him. He did not help him and was not getting involved. He knew the inmate but did not know much about him. A couple of inmates did finally help him. When he saw Inmate Zaveta again he was sitting on his bed. That is all he knows. **(Exhibit B-19)**

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate Travis Harris, DC# N18475 indicated the following:

He knew Inmate Zaveta and talked to him on occasion. He was not aware of problems with other inmates. He (*Inmate Harris*) was returning from recreation when he entered into the dormitory and saw Inmate Zaveta lying on the floor, [REDACTED] Inmates helped him off the floor, onto the bed. [REDACTED] The inmate would not let him lay down [REDACTED] He did not see what happened but other inmates said he (*Inmate Zaveta*) [REDACTED] **(Exhibit B-20)**



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In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate Tommy Hunter, DC# P32107 indicated the following:

He had been in E-dormitory for about two months. He knew Inmate Zaveta and talked to him on occasion. He did not see anything surrounding the inmate's fall. At the time of the incident he was on his bunk, lying on his stomach, looking out the window towards H-dormitory. Everything happened behind him. (Exhibit B-21)

In his sworn, digitally recorded interview dated July 14, 2009, by Inspector Rodney Coffey, Inmate Marcos Nopal, DC# K71851 indicated the following:

He had been in E-dormitory about two months. He knew Inmate Zaveta for about a year from another dormitory. He knew of no problems Inmate Zaveta had with other inmates. He did not see what happened as he was in the shower. When he came out of the shower [REDACTED] He heard from another inmate (*unknown*) he fell down. (Exhibit B-22)

On July 14, 2009, an attempt was made to interview Inmate Xavier Thomas, DC# P23818. The inmate was placed into confinement as he was uncooperative (kept falling asleep when being questioned) and refused to participate in the interview. He was upset in being awoke in order to be interviewed about something he had no knowledge about. Note: Inmate Thomas was not re-interviewed as he had no knowledge of the incident. (Case notes)

In his written statement dated October 29, 2009, Institutional Inspector Rodney Coffey indicated the following:

On July 20, 2009, he attended the autopsy of Inmate Zaveta. The Medical Examiner stated Inmate Zaveta's injuries were consistent with a fall. There were no signs Inmate Zaveta had been struck with an object or by a person. He had an [REDACTED] consistent with a fall. [REDACTED] one to believe foul play was involved. Additional tests would be conducted to determine if there were any underlying causes for his fall. (Exhibit A-11)

On July 24, 2009, SHSA Beverly Bottoms forwarded a completed [REDACTED] completed by [REDACTED], surrounding the death of Inmate Jeffery Zaveta. The history indicated [REDACTED] On July 13, 2009, Inmate Zaveta [REDACTED], fell down, hit his head on the floor [REDACTED] He was [REDACTED] and then [REDACTED] at 1920 hours on July 13, 2009. [REDACTED] The inmate [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] the conclusion was the inmate was pronounced dead a 2:40 pm, on July 19, 2009, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] on July 13, 2009, when he fell in E-dormitory. (Exhibit A-12)

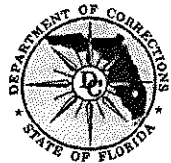
