In an incident report submitted on May 20, 2011, Sergeant Branden Johnson indicated the following:

At approximately 6:30 AM on May 20, 2011, while picking up trays from the morning meal in V-Dorm, he approached cell V1-114 which houses Inmate Alan Hunter. He opened the tray flap of Inmate Hunter and noticed that Inmate Hunter had not eaten his tray and was lying on the floor of his cell. Inmate Hunter did not respond with attempts to communicate with him. He summoned additional staff to the dorm, activated the ICS System, and notified Lieutenant Timmy Robinson. When Lieutenant Robinson and additional staff arrived at the cell front, the cell door was breached and Inmate Hunter was restrained. In an incident report submitted on May 20, 2011, Officer Josue Sanchez indicated the following:

At approximately 6:02 AM (this appears to be a typographical error in the type written report because according to the fixed wing video and Officer Sanchez's handwritten incident report the time should read approximately 6:35 AM) while assigned as Housing Officer in V-Dorm he was summoned via radio to respond to the cell of Inmate Hunter due to him being. After commands by Lieutenant Robinson he breached the cell door, placed the shield over the body of Inmate Hunter, who was lying on the cell floor, and pinned him to the floor. Inmate Hunter remained.

In an incident report submitted on May 20, 2011, Officer Lee Thompson indicated the following:

At approximately 6:02 AM on May 20, 2011, while assigned as Housing Officer in V-Dorm he fed the morning meal and placed a tray in the cell of Inmate Hunter. He observed what appeared to be the leg of Inmate Hunter out of his bed in an attempt to get up. He exited the quad to take count slips up to the control room upon orders by Sergeant Johnson. When Inmate Hunter's cell was breached he was the second person in the cell and placed hand restraints on Inmate Hunter without force being used. He was then part of the escort that took Inmate Hunter to (Exhibit A3)

In an incident report submitted on May 20, 2011, Officer Donald Barton II indicated the following:

At approximately 6:30 AM he was called to assist in responding to an immate in V-Dorm. Officers Sanchez, Thompson, and he were instructed by Lieutenant Robinson to breach the cell door of Inmate Hunter. Officer Sanchez entered first and placed the shield on Inmate Hunter. Officer Thompson and he then placed hand and leg restraints, respectively, on Inmate Hunter. After restraints were applied.

He lived in the cell across from Inmate Hunter and saw Inmate Hunter standing at his door after showers on May 19, 2011. Inmate Hunter was not beating on his door or having any problems that he could see or hear.

In a sworn written Affidavit submitted on May 20, 2011, Inmate Raymond Doolittle indicated the following:

He was placing food trays in the food boxes of the inmates on the quad. He did not see anything out of the ordinary at all. (Exhibit A10)

In a sworn written Affidavit submitted on May 20, 2011, Inmate Darrell Bowers indicated the following:

He arrived for work in V-Dorm at 4:15 AM. He came onto Inmate Hunter's quad the first time at 5:45 AM but did not go to Inmate Hunter's cell front because he was passing out diet trays and Inmate Hunter did not get that type of tray. He did not see anything out of the ordinary. (Exhibit A11)

In a sworn written Affidavit submitted on May 20, 2011, Inmate Ronnie Allen indicated the following:

He is an orderly in V-Dorm and arrived for work at 4:30 AM. He was serving the breakfast beverage and did not see or hear anything during the time he was serving breakfast. (Exhibit A12)

Photographs were taken of Inmate Hunter's cell and his deceased body to be entered into evidence.

A search of Inmate Hunter's cell did not reveal any items of an evidentiary value.

Inmate Hunter comes out of his cell for showering at 5:58 PM and is placed back in his cell at 6:07 PM. Staff members are observed making their security checks according to procedure for the next 12 hours. A security staff escorting her. At 6:07 AM security staff members are viewed passing out trays on the wing with inmate orderlies. They arrive at Inmate Hunter's cell at 6:14 AM, place his tray in the flap, and continue on feeding the other inmates. At 6:32 AM security staff members are viewed picking up trays on the quad with the inmate orderlies. At 6:35 AM the inmate orderlies exit the wing and three staff members go to the cell front of Inmate Hunter. At 6:39 AM Inmate Hunter's cell door is breached and staff members enter the cell. At 6:49 AM Inmate Hunter is






