

The letter found in Inmate Bennett's bible, was written on a piece of white notebook paper. The letter was written in black ink, addressed to "Terence Edmonson, Office of the Inspector General." The verbiage indicated that Inmate Bennett had received a "DR" and the officer served it to him. The letter stated, "the officer that served the DR told him" he (Inmate Bennett) "did not want to participate and if he said otherwise," he (Inmate Bennett) would receive another disciplinary report. It continued with, "This is cruel and unusual and murder, 2nd shift, (Exhibit B6)
