On January 25, 2011, at approximately 6:25am, [REDACTED] pronounced Inmate William Lemon DC# M68900 dead [REDACTED]. The incident was entered into MINS on January 7, 2011 and assigned for investigation on January 12, 2011.

Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner's Office Autopsy Protocol Report prepared by Dr. Kenneth D. Huthcins, Associate Medical Examiner cite Inmate Lemon's cause of death as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] Miami-Dade Police Homicide Bureau is conducting the homicide investigation.
